





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz

as of 29 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Rizal Street in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz. The fire was declared out at around 2:47 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 107 families or 381 persons are affected in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **71 families** or **268 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Rufina Andrada Santos Memorial School** in **Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **36 families** or **113 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **107 families** or **381 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz** (see Annex F).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **85 houses** were damaged; of which, **83** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz** (see Annex G).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱1,401,424.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱876,424.00 from DSWD and ₱525,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex H).

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 108,907 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 91,838 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 17,069 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

28 February 2024	 DSWD FO VI distributed FNIs to the families affected by the fire incident. The LGU of Roxas City through its Health Unit facilitated the provision of medicines and vitamins to the displaced families.

c. Other Activities

DATE	ACTIVITIES
28 February 2024	 The LGU of Roxas City through its Health Unit conducted medical checkup to the displaced families and persons. DSWD FO VI spearheaded by Assistant Regional Director for Administration (ARDA) Joselito G. Estember visited the open evacuation center to conduct needs assessment of the IDPs and provided technical assistance to the LGU of Roxas City. DSWD FO VI maintained close coordination with the LGU of Roxas for significant disaster response updates and for further relief augmentation requests.
27 February 2024	DSWD FO VI led by the Social Welfare and Development (SWAD) Team Leader provided technical assistance to the Roxas City Social Welfare and Development Office in the assessment and provision of immediate needs of the IDPs.
