



# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Puntod, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental

as of 21 February 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 12 February 2024 at around 1:49 PM, a fire incident occurred at St. John, Brgy. Puntod, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 2:30 PM.

## **II.** Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **64 families** or **222 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Puntod, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **22 families** or **98 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in a **Covered Court** in **Brgy. Puntod, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **42 families** or **124 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **64 families** or **222 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Puntod, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **40 houses** were damaged; of which, **33** are **totally damaged** and **seven (7)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Puntod, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱219,672.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex F).
