I. Situation Overview

On 03 February 2024 at around 8:05 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Tingub, Mandaue City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 8:58 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **79 families** or **225 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tingub, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **79 families** or **225 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Tingub Elementary School** in **Brgy. Tingub, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **22 houses** were damaged; of which, **18** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Tingub, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex C).
