





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental

as of 22 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 February 2024 at around 3:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 5:25 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 15 families or 65 persons are affected in Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 10 families or 40 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Multipurpose Hall in Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 13 houses were damaged; of which, nine (9) are totally damaged and four (4) are partially damaged in Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱432,476.70 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱126,386.70 from DSWD and ₱306,090.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
