

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental as of 22 February 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 19 February 2024 at around 3:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 5:25 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **15 families** or **65 persons** are affected in **Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **10 families** or **40 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Multipurpose Hall in Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **13 houses** were damaged; of which, **nine (9)** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱432,476.70** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱126,386.70** from **DSWD** and **₱306,090.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
