I. Situation Overview

On 23 February 2024 at around 11:13 PM, a fire incident occurred at Backside St., Brgy. Vergara, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 2:06 AM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) NCR

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **60 families** or **186 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Vergara, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **60 families** or **186 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Brgy. Vergara, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **57 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Vergara, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex C).
