## I. Situation Overview

On 07 February 2024 at around 2:29 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Bagong Silang in Puerto Princesa City, which eventually reached and affected Brgy. Pagkakaisa.

A total of 695 families or 2,894 persons are affected in two (2) barangays in Puerto Princesa City (see Annex A).

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are 695 families or 2,894 persons currently taking temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Puerto Princesa City (see Annex B).
