

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Armed Conflict in Lanao del Norte

as of 25 February 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 16 February 2024, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Pantao, Munai, Lanao del Norte between Dawlah Islamiyah – Maute Group (DI-MG) and the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) which resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area and the nearby Municipality of Tangcal, Lanao del Norte.

Another encounter occurred between the two (2) groups in Brgy. Lindongan and Brgy. Matampay in the Municipality of Munai, Lanao del Norte on 18 February 2024 and 21 February 2024, respectively.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **225 families** or **1,111 persons** are affected in **seven (7) barangays** in **Lanao del Norte** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **12 families** or **60 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Banisilon Central Elementary School** in **Tangcal, Lanao del Norte** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **213 families** or **1,051 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **225 families** or **1,111 persons** displaced in **Lanao del Norte** (see Annex D).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱193,318.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex E).
