





DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Armed Conflict in Negros Occidental

as of 24 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2024 at around 3:00 PM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Pinapugasan, City of Escalante, Negros Occidental between the troops of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) that resulted in the displacement of families and persons in the nearby municipality.

On the following day, families and individuals in Brgy. San Isidro in Toboso, Negros Occidental were also affected due to the ongoing hot pursuit of the Philippine Army.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 268 families or 1,092 persons are affected in three (3) barangays in Negros Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 240 families or 980 persons currently taking temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Negros Occidental (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P971,364.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).

Deployed Disaster Response and Management Division staff in the affected LGUs to provide technical assistance in the management of the evacuation centers and to ensure the maintenance and observance of the rights of the Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs).
