





DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Collapsed Church in Brgy. Tungkong Mangga, City of San Jose del Monte, Bulacan

as of 20 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 February 2024 at around 7:00 AM, the second floor of St. Peter Church in Brgy. Tungkong Mangga, San Jose Del Monte City, Bulacan collapsed resulting in several casualties.

Relative to the incident, the reported casualties were immediately transported to the nearest hospital for appropriate medical care. In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region III, promptly provided financial assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.
