

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 330, Sta. Cruz, Manila City as of 26 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 February 2023 at around 11:26 AM, a fire incident occurred at Alonzo cor. Fugoso St., Brgy. 330, Sta. Cruz, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 12:41 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **121 families** or **425 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 330, Sta. Cruz, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **121 families** or **425 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **79 houses** were damaged; of which, **61** are **totally damaged** and **18** are **partially damaged** in in **Brgy. 330, Sta. Cruz, Manila City** (see Annex C).
