





# DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz

as of 29 February 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Rizal Street in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz. The fire was declared out at around 2:47 PM.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 102 families or 385 persons are affected in Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **70 families** or **271 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Rufina Andrada Santos Memorial School** in **Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz** (see Annex B).

## b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **32 families** or **114 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **102 families** or **385 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz** (see Annex F).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **85 houses** were damaged; of which, **83** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion VII, Roxas City, Capiz** (see Annex G).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}2,421,424.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}1,896,424.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}525,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex H).
