





DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan

as of 17 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 February 2024 at around 10:05 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City. The fire was declared out at around 11:30 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **19 families** or **60 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **19 families** or **60 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Rural Health Center** in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 10 houses were damaged; of which, seven (7) are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}129,628.05\$ worth of assistance was provided by the \$\mathbb{DSWD}\$ to the affected families; composed of \$\mathbb{P}59,628.05\$ food and non-food items (FNIs), and \$\mathbb{P}129,628.05\$ financial assistance through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS).
