





DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tingub, Mandaue City, Cebu

as of 08 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 03 February 2024 at around 8:05 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tingub, Mandaue City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 8:58 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **81 families** or **230 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tingub, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **81 families** or **230 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Tingub Elementary School** in **Brgy. Tingub, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **28 houses** were damaged; of which, **25** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Tingub, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}\$1,019,063.80 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}\$489,063.80 from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}\$530,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex E).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱737.47 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 283,072 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 270,738 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 12,334 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 99,816 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱652.76 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

07 February 2024	DSWD FO VII distributed FNIs to the families affected by the fire incident.

c. Internally Displaced Person (IDP) Protection

DATE	ACTIVITIES
05 February 2024	 The City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) of the LGU of Mandaue City conducted stress debriefing sessions to the families and individuals affected by the fire incident. DSWD FO VII visited the evacuation center to check the situation of the IDPs.

d. Other Activities

DATE	ACTIVITIES
07 February 2024	 DSWD FO VII closely coordinated with its City Action Team (CAT), the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), and City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO) and CSWDO of the LGU of Mandaue City for significant updates and any requests for relief augmentation. The LGU of Mandaue City provided financial assistance to the affected families amounting to a total of ₱530,000.00.
