

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tingub, Mandaue City, Cebu as of 08 February 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 03 February 2024 at around 8:05 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tingub, Mandaue City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 8:58 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **81 families** or **230 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tingub, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **81 families** or **230 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Tingub Elementary School** in **Brgy. Tingub, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **28 houses** were damaged; of which, **25** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Tingub, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex D).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,019,063.80** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱489,063.80** from **DSWD** and **₱530,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).
