



DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Vergara, Mandaluyong City

as of 04 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 February 2024 at around 11:13 PM, a fire incident occurred at Backside St., Brgy. Vergara, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 2:06 AM the next day.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in the National Capital Region, provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **51 families** or **183 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Vergara, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **51 families** or **183 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Vergara Covered Court** in **Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **57 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Vergara, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱310,029.15** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).

- 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items
 - 121,425 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 104,356 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 17,069 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
 - 35,118 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
 - ₱429.2 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.

24 February 2024	 The City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) of the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Mandaluyong City conducted intake interviews, master listing and assessment and validation on the affected families and individuals using the Disaster Assistance Family Access Card (DAFAC).

04 March 2024	 DSWD FO NCR maintains close coordination with the affected LGU and all concerned offices for significant updates and further relief augmentation requests.
24 February 2024	 DSWD FO NCR closely coordinates with the CSWDO of the LGU of Mandaluyong City for significant disaster response updates and possible relief augmentation requests. DSWD FO NCR ensures the availability of FNIs. The CSWDO activated its response cluster.
