





# DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Puerto Princesa City, Palawan

as of 15 February 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 07 February 2024 at around 2:29 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Bagong Silang in Puerto Princesa City, which eventually reached and affected Brgy. Pagkakaisa.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **681 families** or **2,952 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Puerto Princesa City** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 383 families or 1,462 persons currently taking temporary shelter in four (4) evacuation centers in Puerto Princesa City (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **298 families** or **1,490 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

## c. Total Displaced Population

There are **681 families** or **2,952 persons** displaced in **Puerto Princesa City** (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **569 houses** were damaged; of which, **552** are **totally damaged** and **17** are **partially damaged** in **Puerto Princesa City** (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}\_{7,382,449.79}\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}\_{2,616,546.60}\$ from \$DSWD\$ and \$\mathbb{P}\_{4,765,903.19}\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
