

# DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Effects of Trough of Low Pressure Area (LPA) as of 02 February 2024, 6PM

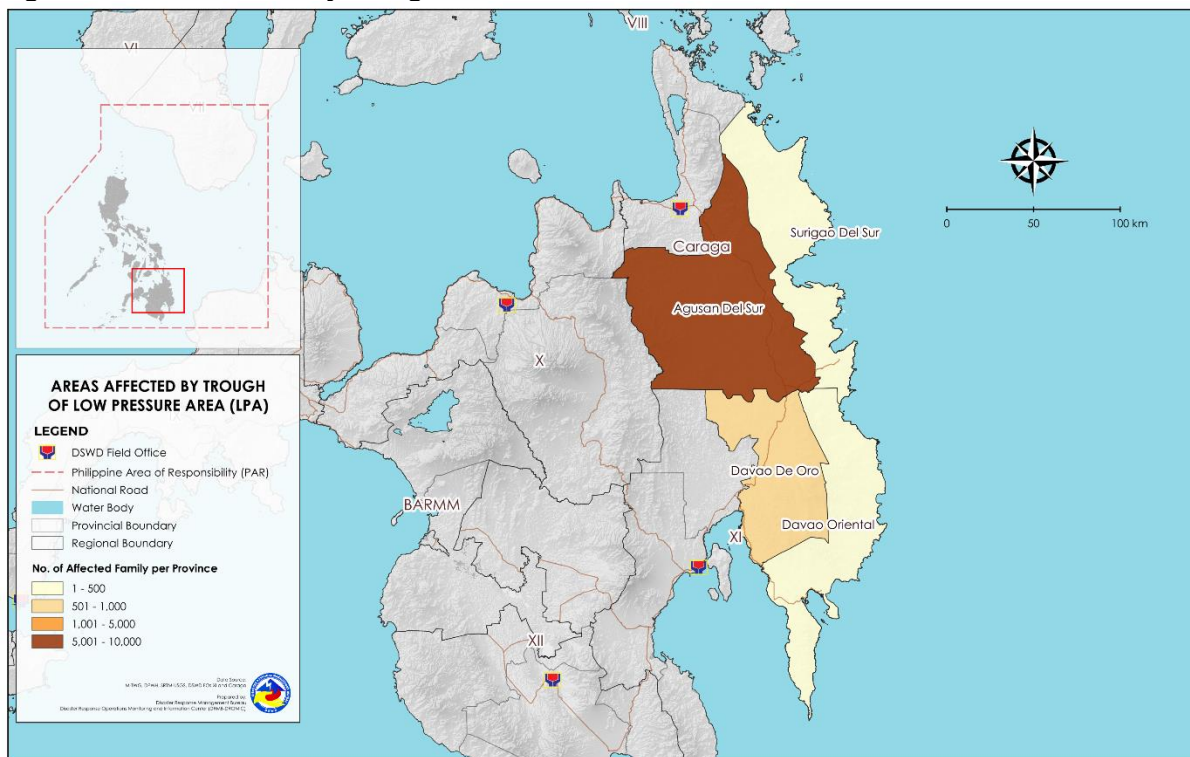
## I. Situation Overview

On 29 January 2024, the Municipalities of Compostela, Monkayo, and New Bataan in Davao de Oro and the Municipalities of Bunawan and Rosario in Agusan del Sur experienced the effects of the trough of LPA.

Issued on 02 February 2024, at 4PM, Mindanao is experiencing cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms caused by the trough of LPA, which may bring possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **147,391 families** or **608,424 persons** are affected in **396 barangays** in **Regions XI and Caraga** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **18,594 families** or **72,121 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **299 evacuation centers** in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **45,051 families** or **182,026 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **63,545 families** or **253,647 persons** displaced in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex F).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **72 houses** were damaged; of which, **41** are **totally damaged** and **31** is **partially damaged** in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex G).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱8,039,489.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱2,701,399.00** from **DSWD**, and **₱3,343,090.00** from the **Local Government Units (LGUs)** (see Annex H).
