





# DSWD DROMIC Report #5 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Carreta, Cebu City

as of 04 February 2024, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 06 January 2024 at around 9:23 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Kalapukan, Brgy. Carreta, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 10:48 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **155 families** or **631 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Carreta, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **90 families** or **534 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Carreta Elementary School** in **Brgy. Carreta, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **65 families** or **97 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are 155 families or 631 persons displaced in Brgy. Carreta, Cebu City (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **87 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Carreta, Cebu City** (see Annex E).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱4,530,247.25 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱985,087.25 from DSWD and ₱3,545,160.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).

09 January 2024	DSWD FO VII's City / Municipality Action Team (C/MAT) together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Cebu City through its Department of Social Welfare Services (DSWS) distributed relief goods and hot meals to the IDPs in Carreta Elementary School.
07 January 2024	<ul> <li>DSWD FO VII provided Ready-to-Eat food (RTEF) and bottled water to the affected families and individuals by the fire incident.</li> <li>The LGU of Cebu City provided hot meals to the affected families and individuals by the fire incident.</li> </ul>

07 January 2024	DSWD FO VII Assistant Regional Director for Administration (ARDA), Tonyson Luther Lee, together with the Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) Chief and the C/MAT visited the evacuation center to assess the needs of the displaced families and individuals.
06 January 2024	<ul> <li>DSWD FO VII through the DRMD alerted the DSWD FO VII Quick Response Team (QRT) to take swift action and secure its premises from potential fire impact.</li> <li>DSWD FO VII spearheaded by ARDA Tonyson Luther Lee visited and checked the DSWD FO and coordinated with the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) and the City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (CDRRMO).</li> <li>DSWD FO VII led by ARDA Lee together with the DRMD Chief and the FOs Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM) coordinator visited the identified EC to assess the needs and ensure the welfare of the fire-affected families as well as provide assistance in the management of the camp/s.</li> </ul>
