

# DSWD DROMIC Report #6 on the Effects of Trough of Low Pressure Area (LPA) as of 04 February 2024, 6AM

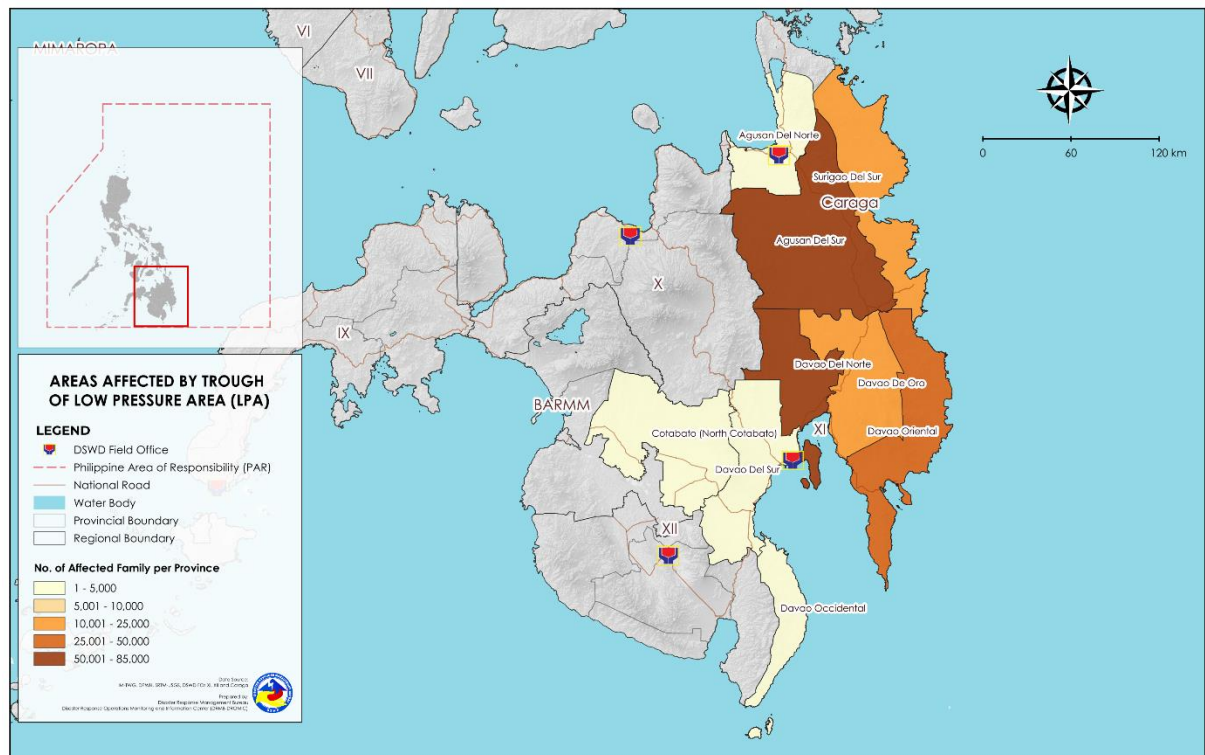
## I. Situation Overview

On 29 January 2024, the Municipalities of Compostela, Monkayo, and New Bataan in Davao de Oro and the Municipalities of Bunawan and Rosario in Agusan del Sur experienced the effects of the trough of LPA.

Issued on 03 February 2024 at 11AM, the LPA Southwest of Zamboanga City, Zamboanga del Sur has dissipated. However, Basilan, Sulu, and Tawi-Tawi may still experience scattered rain showers and thunderstorms in the next 24 hours.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **192,395 families** or **767,423 persons** are affected in **502 barangays** in **Regions XI, XII, and Caraga** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **21,051 families** or **81,867 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **303 evacuation centers** in **Regions XI, XII, and Caraga** (see Annex B).

**b. Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **46,308 families** or **183,955 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

**c. Total Displaced Population**

There are **67,359 families** or **265,822 persons** displaced in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex F).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **100 houses** were damaged; of which, **51** are **totally damaged** and **49** are partially **damaged** in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex G).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱6,491,872.00** worth of **food** and **non-food items (FNIs)** were provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Table 1).
