





DSWD DROMIC Report #6 on the Landslide Incidents in Maco, Davao de Oro

as of 12 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 06 February 2024 at around 4:00 PM, cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and thunderstorms caused by Easterlies may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Davao Region, SOCCSKSARGEN, Southern Leyte, Dinagat Islands, Surigao del Norte, and Surigao del Sur.

On the same day at approximately 7:40 PM, a landslide caused by the effects of Easterlies occurred in Barangays Elizalde, Mainit, Masara, and Tagbaros in Maco, Davao de Oro. The incident resulted in the displacement of affected families / individuals and several reported casualties.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 1,637 families or 6,356 persons are affected in four (4) barangays in Maco, Davao de Oro (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 1,637 families or 6,356 persons currently taking temporary shelter in 13 evacuation centers in Maco and Mawab, Davao de Oro (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P2,296,835.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
