

DSWD DROMIC Report #7 on the Effects of Trough of Low Pressure Area (LPA) as of 04 February 2024, 6PM

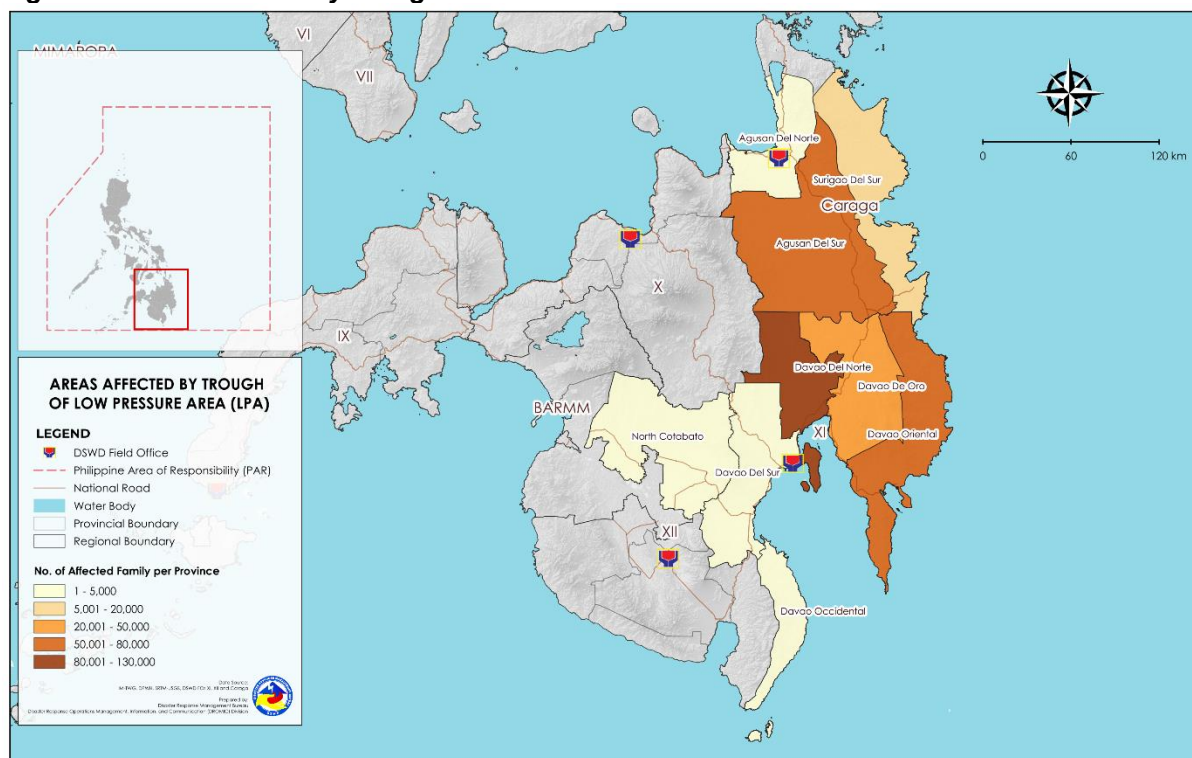
I. Situation Overview

On 29 January 2024, the Municipalities of Compostela, Monkayo, and New Bataan in Davao de Oro and the Municipalities of Bunawan and Rosario in Agusan del Sur experienced the effects of the Trough of Low Pressure Area (LPA).

Issued on 03 February 2024 at 11:00 AM, the LPA Southwest of Zamboanga City, Zamboanga del Sur has dissipated. However, Basilan, Sulu, and Tawi-Tawi may still experience scattered rain showers and thunderstorms in the next 24 hours.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **304,312 families** or **1,079,368 persons** are affected in **625 barangays** in **Regions XI, XII, and Caraga** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **21,757 families** or **82,810 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **324 evacuation centers** in **Regions XI and Caraga** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **82,463 families** or **312,873 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **104,220 families** or **395,683 persons** displaced in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex F).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **769 houses** were damaged; of which, **338** are **totally damaged** and **431** are **partially damaged** in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex G).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱26,948,373.00** worth of **food and non-food items (FNIs)** were provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Table 1).
