

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Magkalungay, San Fernando, Bukidnon

23 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On November 2018, an armed conflict transpired between the troops of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and members of the Communist Party of Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) affecting the Sities of Sil-angon, Pandarasdasan, Spring Kawayan, and Old Tibugawan Kawayan in Brgy. Magkalungay, San Fernando, Bukidnon.

A total of **252 families** or **986 persons** sought temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Magkalungay, San Fernando, Bukidnon** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱628,568.64** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
