I. Situation Overview

On 28 January 2024 at around 2:41 AM, a fire incident occurred at Building 11, Katuparan St., Brgy. 101, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 3:28 AM.

One (1) house was totally destroyed due to fire in **Brgy. 101, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).

A total of **₱67,881.45** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
