



DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Damilisan, Miagao, Iloilo.

11 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 January 2024 at around 5:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Damilisan, Miagao, Iloilo. Based on the report from the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO), there were six (6) damaged houses and seven (7) affected families due to incident. The fire was declared out at around 7:00 PM.

In response to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, provided intervention to support the immediate needs of affected families and individuals by means of relief assistance.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of seven (7) families or 15 persons were affected in Brgy. Damilisan, Miagao, Iloilo. (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **seven (7) families** or **15 persons** sought temporary shelter in **Brgy. Damilisan, Miagao, Iloilo** (see Annex B) and (Annex C) for the breakdown of disaggregated data.

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were damaged; of which, five (5) are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. Damilisan, Miagao, Iloilo. (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱41,060.46** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families from **DSWD** (see Annex E).


