





# DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Santa Catalina, Negros Occidental

23 February 2024, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 02 January 2024 at around 7:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion, Santa Catalina, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 10:10 PM.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of three (3) families or 17 persons were affected in Brgy. Poblacion, Santa Catalina, Negros Occidental (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **three (3) families** or **17 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Poblacion, Santa Catalina, Negros Occidental (see Annex C).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P104,096.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **P22,896.00** from **DSWD**, **P75,200.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)**, and **P6,000.00** from the **Non-Government Organization (NGO)** (see Annex D).
