

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sevilla, City of San Fernando, La Union

24 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 February 2024 at around 8:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 6 in Brgy. Sevilla, City of San Fernando, La Union.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **seven (7) families** or **22 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Sevilla, City of San Fernando, La Union** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **four (4) families** or **11 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Sevilla Multipurpose Hall** in **Brgy. Sevilla, City of San Fernando, La Union** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **four (4) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** is **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Sevilla, City of San Fernando, La Union** (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱83,961.58** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱60,899.58** from **DSWD** and **₱23,062.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).
