





# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Hog Cholera in Negros Occidental

06 April 2024, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 27 April 2023, the Province of Negros Occidental confirmed the widespread swine deaths caused by hog cholera, African swine fever (ASF) and even bird flu within the province. Hence, the concerned LGUs were highly encouraged to strengthen their respective animal biosecurity measures within their respective areas of responsibility (AOR) in coordination with the Veterinary Health Office (VHO).

On 31 May 2023, the Bago City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (CDRRMC) in coordination with the City Veterinary Office (CVO) and the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) confirmed swine deaths likewise, similar cases of swine deaths caused by hog cholera were also confirmed in the Municipality of San Enrique, Negros Occidental, which affected the livelihood of hog raisers in the said locality.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected hog raisers.
