

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Northeast Monsoon in Bicol Region

29 July 2024, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

Issued on 13 January 2024 at 4Am, partly cloudy skies with light rains caused by the Northeast Monsoon were experienced in Bicol Region.

From January 16 to 30, 2024, severe weather conditions including rough seas and strong winds affected the Seaboards of Southern Luzon, prompting the issuance of gale warnings in certain areas of the Bicol Region. This situation significantly impacted fisherfolk along the Eastern Seaboards of Southern Luzon, who rely on fishing as their main livelihood.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Office in Region V promptly provided relief assistance as a support to the immediate needs of the affected populace.

A total of **16,891 families** or **84,455 persons** were affected in **85 barangays** in **Albay, Camarines Norte, Camarines Sur and Sorsogon** in **Bicol Region** (see Annex A).

A total of **₱7,458,692.60** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to affected families (see Annex B).
