





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident at the Auxiliary Wet Market in Brgy. Ilocanos Sur, City of San Fernando, La Union

19 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 January 2024 at around 2:20 AM, a fire incident occurred at the Auxiliary Wet Market, a public wet market in Brgy. Ilocanos Sur, City of San Fernando, La Union that affected the livelihood of stall owners and vendors.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region I, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of City San Fernando, actively engaged in the response operation and promptly provided relief and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

A total of **1,907 stall owners and vendors** were affected in the **City of San Fernando**, **La Union** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱18,593,395.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of ₱16,060,395.00 from DSWD, ₱1,345,500.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU), and ₱1,187,500.00 from Other Partners (see Annex B).
