





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Candulawan, City of Talisay, Cebu

04 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2024 at around 4:38 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Mahayahay, Brgy. Candulawan, City of Talisay, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 4:58 PM.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VII, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Talisay City, provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 21 families or 83 persons are affected in Brgy. Candulawan, City of Talisay, Cebu (see Annex A).

I. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **16 families** or **73 persons** sought temporary shelter at a **covered court** in **Brgy. Candulawan, City of Talisay, Cebu** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **five (5) families** or **10 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of 21 families or 83 persons were displaced in Brgy. Candulawan, City of Talisay, Cebu (see Annex D).

III. Damaged Houses

A total of 16 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Candulawan, City of Talisay, Cebu (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P767,751.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; composed of **P365,551.00** from **DSWD** and **P402,200.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex C).
