

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City

01 June 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2024 at around 3:41 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City. The fire was declared out at around 5:52 PM.

A total of **130 families** or **480 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

130 families or **480 persons** sought temporary shelter in **Purok 4 Satellite Office** in **Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

51 houses were totally damaged in **Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

₱87,085.70 worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
