#### I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2024 at around 3:41 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City. The fire was declared out at around 5:52 PM.

51 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Culiat, Quezon City (see Annex E).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided
