





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Mansasa, Tagbilaran City, Bohol

25 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 February 2024 at around 3:10 PM, a fire incident in Brgy. Mansasa, Tagbilaran City, Bohol. The fire was declared out at around 4:45 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **35 families** or **91 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Mansasa**, **Tagbilaran City**, **Bohol** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **35 families** or **91 persons** sought temporary shelter in **Baliw Covered Court** in **Brgy. Mansasa, Tagbilaran City, Bohol** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 12 houses were damaged; of which, nine (9) are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. Mansasa, Tagbilaran City, Bohol (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}445,000.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}225,000.00\$ from DSWD through AICS and \$\mathbb{P}220,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
