

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Lingayen, Pangasinan

19 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 February 2024 at around 3:15 PM, a fire incident occurred at P. Moran West Street, Brgy. Poblacion, Lingayen, Pangasinan.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region I, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Lingayen, Pangasinan, actively engaged in the response operation and promptly provided relief and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **18 families** or **69 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Poblacion, Lingayen, Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **10 families** or **45 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Lingayen Evacuation Center** in **Brgy. Poblacion, Lingayen, Pangasinan** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **eight (8) families** or **24 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **18 families** or **69 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Poblacion, Lingayen, Pangasinan** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **12 houses** were damaged; of which, **10 are totally damaged** and **two (2) are partially damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion, Lingayen, Pangasinan** (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱213,248.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱206,948.80** from **DSWD** and **₱6,300.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex G).
