

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Nicolas, La Paz, Iloilo City

11 April 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 February 2024 at around 4:15 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. San Nicolas, La Paz, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 5:24 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **194 families** or **207 persons** were affected in **Brgy. San Nicolas** in **La Paz, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **six (6) families** or **six (6) persons** sought temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Brgy. San Nicolas, La Paz, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **183 families** or **188 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **189 families** or **194 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. San Nicolas, La Paz, Iloilo City** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **seven (7) houses** were damaged; of which, **five (5)** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. San Nicolas, La Paz, Iloilo City** (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,857,623.50** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱1,741,248.00** from **DSWD** and **₱116,375.50** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex G).
