





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sum-ag, Bacolod City

18 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 February 2024 at around 7:20 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Sum-ag, Bacolod City. The fire was declared out at around 9:25 AM.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Bacolod City, provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **nine (9) families** or **43 persons** were affected in **Barangay Sum-ag**, **Bacolod City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **four (4) families** or **21 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Purok Providence Chapel** in **Barangay Sum-ag, Bacolod City** (see Annex B.

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were damaged; of which, three (3) are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Barangay Sum-ag, Bacolod City (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}93,922.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of \$\mathbb{P}75,922.02\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}18,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex E).
