

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental

11 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 February 2024 at around 3:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 5:25 PM.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Victorias City, provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **15 families** or **65 persons** were affected in **Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **ten (10) families** or **40 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Multipurpose Hall** in **Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **13 houses** were damaged; of which, **nine (9)** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱432,476.70** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱126,386.70** from **DSWD** and **₱ 306,090.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
