





# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Puerto Princesa City, Palawan

19 April 2024, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 07 February 2024 at around 2:29 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Bagong Silang in Puerto Princesa City, Palawan which eventually reached and affected Brgy. Pagkakaisa.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **708 families** or **3,087 persons** were affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Puerto Princesa City**, **Palawan** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **352 families** or **1,374 persons** taking temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **325 families** or **1,625 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

## c. Total Displaced Population

There are **352 families** or **1,374 persons** displaced in **Puerto Princesa City**, **Palawan** (see Annex D).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **569 houses** were damaged; of which, **552** are **totally damaged** and **17** are **partially damaged** in **Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex E).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱18,595,710.85 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱10,701,830.60 from DSWD, ₱2,708,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU), and ₱5,185,880.25 from Other Partners (see Annex F).
