

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incident in Midsayap, North Cotabato

11 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 03 November 2023 at 4AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms to Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day at around 5PM, low-lying barangays in the Municipality of Midsayap, North Cotabato experienced flooding due to localized thunderstorms.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region XII provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,996 families** or **14,832 persons** were affected in **22 barangays** in **Midsayap, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **134 families** or **541 persons** sought temporary shelter in **six (6) evacuation centers** in **Midsayap, North Cotabato** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **159 houses** were damaged; of which, **four (4)** are **totally damaged** and **155** are **partially damaged** in **Midsayap, North Cotabato** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,117,312.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
