
DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Mw 4.2 Earthquake in Banayoyo, Ilocos Sur

21 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2024 at 12:16 AM, a magnitude 4.2 earthquake jolted the Municipality of Banayoyo (Ilocos Sur) (17.28°N, 120.46°E - 005 km N 18° W) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus 003 km. The earthquake was also felt in the neighboring municipalities.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region I, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Banayoyo, Ilocos Sur, provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

A total of **35 families** or **123 persons** were affected in **seven (7) barangays** in **Banayoyo, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

A total of **35 houses** were **partially damaged** in **Banayoyo, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱47,075.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱26,075.00** from the **DSWD** and **₱21,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex C).
