

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Aleosan, North Cotabato

as of 11 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 March 2024 at around 12:30 PM, an armed conflict between two (2) warring groups transpired within the boundaries of Sitio Tubak, Brgy. Pangan and Purok 8, Brgy. Bagolibas in Aleosan, North Cotabato. The incident resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the said areas. A member of the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) 118th Base Command was also left wounded.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **99 families** or **495 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Aleosan, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **99 families** or **495 persons** took temporary shelter at the **Barangay Covered Court** in **Brgy. Bagolibas, Aleosan, North Cotabato** (see Annex B).
