





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Lagandang, Isulan, Sultan Kudarat

as of 20 March 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 11 March 2024 at around 6:10 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Purok 7, Brgy. Lagandang, Isulan, Sultan Kudarat between two (2) alleged members of the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) armed groups also known as "Commander Stallon" and "Commander 05", which resulted in the displacement of the affected families and individuals.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **296 families** or **909 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Lagandang**, **Isulan**, **Sultan Kudarat** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **296 families** or **909 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

## IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱6,920.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱5,320.00 from DSWD and ₱1,600.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex C).
