





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Tonganon, Carmen, North Cotabato

as of 11 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 March 2024, at around 5PM, an armed conflict between two warring groups transpired in Brgy. Tonganon, Carmen, North Cotabato. This incident resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the said area.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 1,234 families or 6,179 persons are affected in Brgy. Tonganon, Carmen, North Cotabato (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 32 families or 160 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Barangay Covered Court in Brgy. Tonganon, Carmen, North Cotabato (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱486,813.00 worth of assistance was provided by the Local Government Unit (LGU) to the affected families (see Annex C).

- ₱493.25 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
