## I. Situation Overview

On 04 January 2024 at around 4:22 AM, an armed conflict occurred at Del Gallego, Camarines Sur.

A total of **24 families** or **120 persons** are affected in **one (1) barangay** in **Del Gallego**, **Camarines Sur** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **24 families** or **120 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

## IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P68,851.20** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families from the **DSWD** (see Annex C).
