



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in San Joaquin, Iloilo

as of 01 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 February 2024 at around 3:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the troops of the 61st Infantry (Hunter) Battalion and Communist NPA Terrorists (CNT) of Southern Panay Front, Komiteng Rehiyon-Panay in the Municipality of San Joaquin, Iloilo.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,492 families** or **10,100 persons** were affected in **27 barangays** in **San Joaquin**, **Iloilo** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱331,170.00 worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex B).
