

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Easterlies in North Cotabato

as of 29 March 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 28 March 2024, the effects of Easterlies were reported in the municipalities of Kabacan, Libungan, and Pigcawayan in Cotabato Province. The Easterlies brought a significant amount of rain associated with strong winds which resulted to the displacement of families and persons.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **114 families** or **562 persons** are affected in **13 barangays** in **Cotabato Province** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

There are **33 families** or **165 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **110 houses** were damaged; of which, **33** are **totally damaged** and **77** are **partially damaged** in **Cotabato Province** (see Annex C).
