





# **DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Easterlies in North Cotabato**

as of 29 March 2024, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 28 March 2024, the effects of Easterlies were reported in the municipalities of Kabacan, Libungan, and Pigcawayan in Cotabato Province. The Easterlies brought a significant amount of rain associated with strong winds which resulted to the displacement of families and persons.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 114 families or 562 persons are affected in 13 barangays in Cotabato Province (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **33 families** or **165 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 110 houses were damaged; of which, 33 are totally damaged and 77 are partially damaged in Cotabato Province (see Annex C).
