

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City as of 22 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 March 2024 at around 10:34 PM, a fire incident occurred at Aroma st., Brgy. 105, Happyland, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out the next day at around 5:28 AM.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in the National Capital Region, actively engaged in the response operation, and continuously coordinating with the concerned LGU for significant updates and possible requests for relief augmentation.
