

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 107, Manila City as of 25 March 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 24 March 2024 at around 7:54 PM, a fire incident occurred at Capulong St. Brgy. 107, Zone 9, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 9:26 PM.
